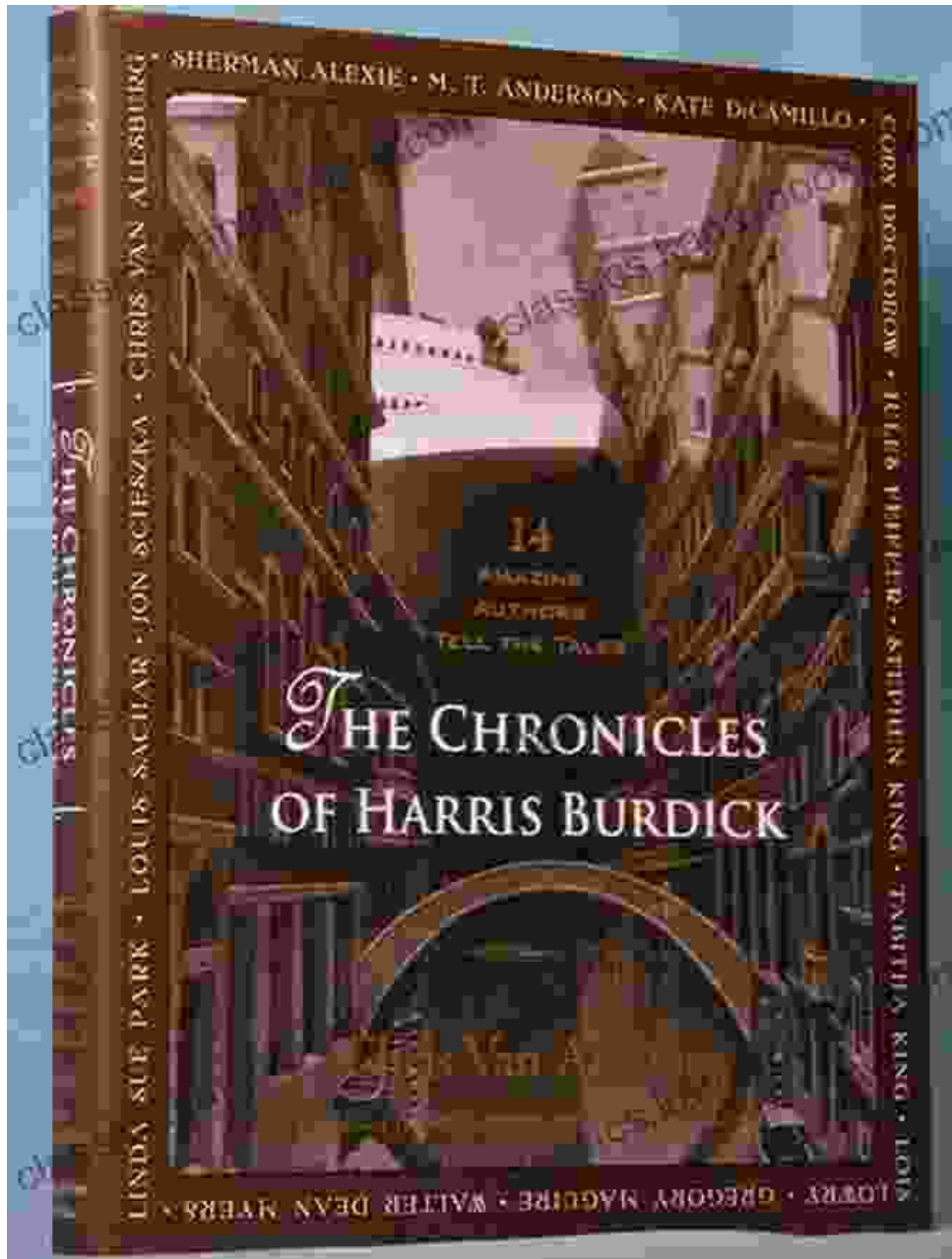
1. Neil Gaiman
